HOW TO MAKE AN EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

1. Begin by asking the Holy Spirit to open our hearts and to remind us of our sins.
2. Every examination of conscience should include some consideration of each one of the Ten Commandments.
3. Review the precepts of the church
 1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation.
 2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
 3. You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least once during the Easter season.
4. Consider the seven deadly sins. Lust, Gluttony, Greed, Sloth, Pride, Envy, Wrath.
5. Consider your station in life. When you consider your station in life, you begin to see both sins of omission and sins of commission that stem from your particular circumstance.
6. Meditate on the Beatitudes. Blessed are the poor in spirit for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted.

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the land.

Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be shown mercy.

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy,

Blessed are the peacemakers for they will be called children of God.

Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

7. End with the act of contrition.

8. Act of Reparation for Blasphemies against the Holy Name.

In today's world, we often hear the names of Jesus spoken casually, at best, and even in anger and blasphemy. Through this act of Reparation, we offer our own prayers to make up for the sins of others.
