## QUESTION OF THE WEEK

What things restrict the Spirit within me and need to be united? Am I sometimes guilty of selfishness, prejudice, dishonesty deceit, exclusion, or mean-spiritedness: Am I willing to overcome these barriers to the Spirit?



If sometimes the flame of charity seems to die in our hearts, it never dies in the heart of God!
