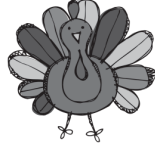
CHRISTMAS COOKIES AND CANDY PLATTERS-OLL

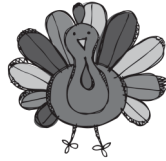
