

## St. James Catholic Church Rosary

**Rosary Leader:** (Mass intention or dedication is chosen by leader).

(Example) We offer this rosary in union with the most sacred heart of Jesus immaculate heart of Mary, the whole community of angels and saints, in repatriation for sin, for all the convergence of sinners.

**All:** Make the sign of the cross

**Rosary leader:** I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

**All:** I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

**Rosary leader:** For an increase of faith, hope, and charity. (love)

**Rosary leader:** Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, the will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.

**All:** give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen

(Say 3 hail Mary's)

**Rosary leader:** Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

**All:** Holy Mary, mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen

**All:** Glory be to the Father and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end amen.

Mysteries: during lent (sorrowful) during advent (joyful) other, Sunday, and Wednesday. (Glorious)

**Rosary leader:** announces first of, each of the five mysteries

**Rosary leader:** Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, the will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.

**All:** Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Say 10 hail Mary's

**Rosary leader:** Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

**All:** as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen

**All:** O my Jesus forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those who most need of thy mercy. Amen

(Optional per rosary leader) said by all:

O sacrament most holy, o sacrament divine, all praise and all thanksgiving, be every moment thine.

**Rosary leader:** announces second of, each of the five mysteries

All: Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of mercy! Our life, our sweetness, and our hope, to thee do we cry, poor banished children of eve; to thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn, then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us; and after this our exile shows unto us, the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, o loving, o sweet Virgin Mary!

Rosary leader: pray for us, holy Mother of God.

All: That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Amen

Rosary leader: Let us pray.

All: O God, whose only begotten Son by his life, death, and resurrection has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech thee, that meditating on these mysteries of the most holy rosary of the blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain, and obtain what the promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen. May the divine assistance remain always with us, and may the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

Rosary leader: Name of saints, (example) St. James

All: pray for us

All: Saint Michael, the archangel, defend us in battle; be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil, may God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou o Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the divine power of God thrust into hell Satan and all the other evil spirits who prowl around the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

Rosary leader: (say three times) most sacred heart of Jesus.

All: (say three times) have mercy on us.

Rosary leader: A prayer for priests.

All: Lord Jesus, grant saintly priests to the world, priests who live close to the Eucharist, who have a deep spiritual life, who work and suffer, yet with a joyful heart; priests who dedicate each minute of their lives for the salvation of souls and your kingdom. Amen

All: Queen of the most Holy Rosary. In these times of brazen impiety, show again thy power, with the signs which accompanied thy victories of old, and from the throne where thou art seated, dispensing pardon and grace, in pity watch over the church of Thy Son, his vicar, and every order of the clergy and laity, suffering in grievous warfare. Hasten, o most powerful destroyer of heresy, hasten the hour of mercy, seeing that the hour of judgment, is daily challenged by innumerable offences. Obtain for me, the lowest of men, kneeling suppliant in thy presence, the grace which may enable me to live a just life on earth, and reign with the just in heaven, whilst with the faithful throughout the world, o Queen of the most holy rosary, I salute thee and cry out: Queen of the most holy rosary pray for us. Amen

All: Pray for us.

All: Sign of the cross.
